



Requirements for Animals

- *There may be circumstances where Denver Zoo Outreach deems animal presence as unfit, and booths may or may not include animals or biofacts due to weather constraints (65° – 85° is acceptable for animals).*
- *Due to the nature of live animals, Denver Zoo Outreach cannot guarantee the number & types of animals utilized in any program.*
- *No other animals may be stationed at or near the booth location.*
- *Booth area should be clear of potential for loud noises (ex. Performance stages, fire trucks with sirens, etc).*
- *Booth should take place indoors unless previous arrangements are made with Denver Zoo Outreach; shade must be provided.*
- *No food or drink is permitted at the booth, especially when interacting with animals.*

Zoo Booth Requirements

- *Booths should take place on the ground level.*
- *Denver Zoo Outreach will arrive 15-45 minutes prior to a scheduled program to unload and set up.*
- *Please provide an unloading and parking area as close to the booth location as possible with access for a rolling cart.*
- *Please provide a large table for use at the booth (8' preferred).*
- *Please have a representative available to meet Zoo Staff or Volunteers upon arrival.*
- *Please note any additional policies or needs specified during the reservation process, including any policies listed in a booth with animals' program agreement.*

Cancellation and reschedule policy:

Cancellations and reschedules made within two weeks from the date of the scheduled program will result in a 50% fee of the total program costs. Reschedules will be accommodated to the best of our ability. Red apple scholarship funds do not apply to any cancellation fees.
