BIRD WORLD

Nearly 200 species, many rare and endangered, are exhibited in Denver Zoo's Bird World and nearby facilities. Each area features naturalistic habitats and replicated tropic and aquatic ecosystems, with the majority of exhibits built without barriers so the birds can fly freely among Zoo visitors. Visitors can also see first hand what the birds eat, at the Bird World Kitchen viewing window.
