## RAINFORESTS

Home to half the plant and animal species on the planet, tropical rainforests offer a rich habitat for mega and microfauna. The broadleaf canopies offer shelter for species of monkey and birds, while ground dwellers such as the elusive okapi are rarely seen in the dense vegetation. Here you can find brightly colored characters such as the poison dart frog and macaw. The abundance of water, food, and shelter make this a vibrant ecosystem teeming with life.
