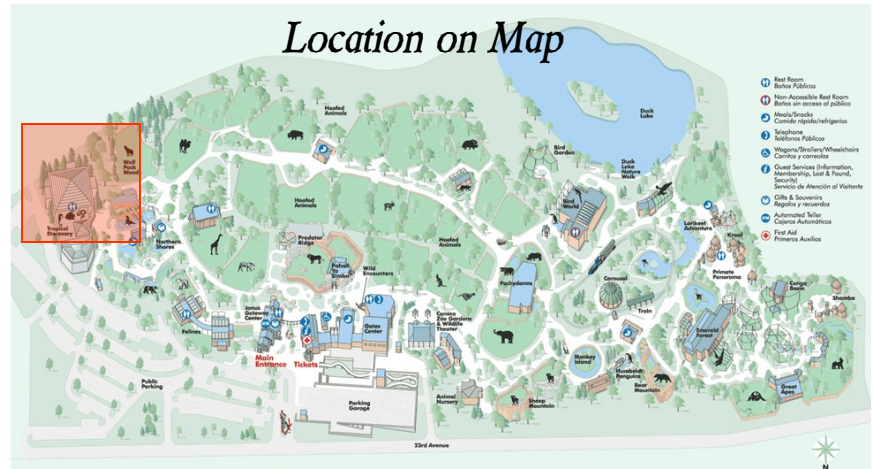


Select Denver Zoo Animal List by Area

TROPICAL DISCOVERY



Enter Tropical Discovery through a winding pathway past waterfalls into a darkened cave where you can explore a temple ruin deep in the heart of the jungle. Next, travel along a tropical riverbank to a mangrove swamp -and spectacular coral reefs - where a variety of fresh-water and marine fish and exotic turtles can be seen swimming in the 2,250-gallon cerulean blue pool. Back on land, wander around a cypress swamp and balmy tropical marsh through the world's largest indoor Komodo dragon habitat before exiting through the Discovery Center.
